

Used Car Check Checklist

A quick worksheet for reviewing listing details, VIN information, seller answers, and common red flags before you move forward.

Checklist
■ Confirm the VIN shown in the listing matches the vehicle paperwork.
■ Compare mileage across the listing, seller notes, and any available report.
■ Ask whether the title is clean, rebuilt, salvage, or branded in any way.
■ Review accident, ownership, and service-history indicators when available.
■ Schedule an independent mechanic inspection before committing.
■ Check taxes, registration costs, insurance, and local import rules.
■ Avoid pressure to pay deposits before you have reviewed the basics.
■ Save screenshots of the listing, seller answers, and agreed terms.

1. Report coverage by country and database
2. Sample report readability
3. Pricing clarity before checkout
4. Refund or support options
